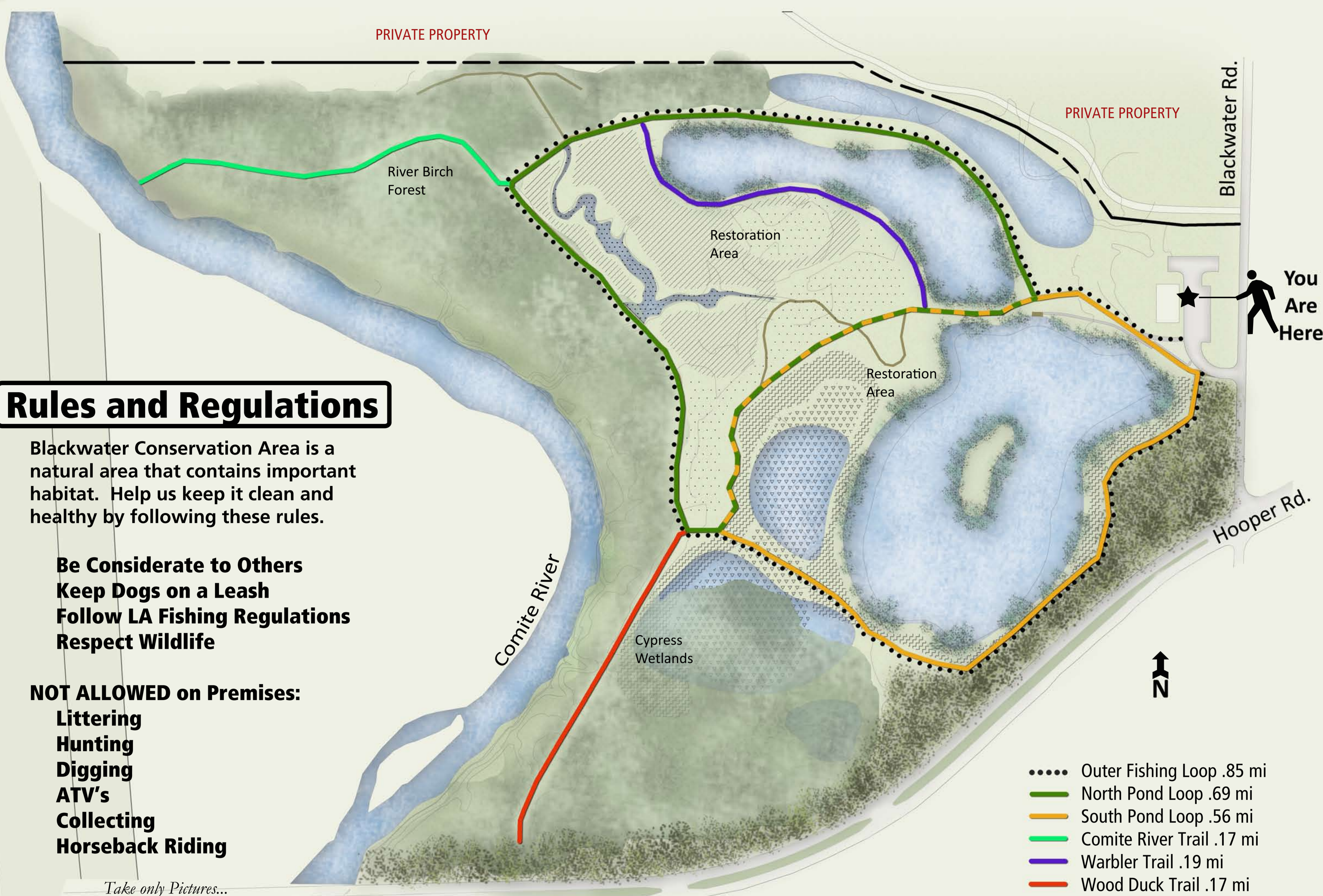

Public Access To The Comite River

- There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Swim at your own risk.
- Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals, Office of Public Health warns of possible high bacteria levels in Louisiana's river waters.
- Reduce your risk by not immersing your head when swimming, avoid swimming with an open cut or sore, shower after swimming and avoid swimming after high rain events.
