AssetWorks or has the contract been executed? The scope of work does not include contract negotiation. The contract is currently in the process of being signed.

- 13. The Period of Agreement indicates a contract term from June 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. Does this align with the AssetWorks implementation timeline? Are there any AssetWorks implementation phase or milestone dates that can be provided? The contract with AssetWorks is in the process of being signed. The dates have not yet been set. It is a strong possibility, though, that the term of the project management services contract will need to be until a to be determined date in 2021.
- 14. Does BREC have a requested or anticipated amount of hours per month for the vendor project manager? Are there any resource requirements for this role included in the AssetWorks proposal and/or contract that can be shared?

BREC does not have a specific anticipated number of hours per month. The role is anticipated to be a part-time role.

Will be the primary point of contact for the Commission and the Assetworks PM
Will be engaged in all aspects the implementation effort
Access and Organize BREC resources
Schedule workshops and meetings
Commit to dates and timelines
Facilitate completing the activities that require BREC staff participation
